

Living and Dying with Dementia:

Let's talk about it!

A new study targeting INFORMAL CAREGIVERS of persons living with dementia will soon be launched throughout Canada.

The study focuses on Informal Caregivers' Attitudes toward Extending Medical Assistance in Dying to Patients with Dementia. It will investigate the beliefs underlying informal caregivers' attitudes on this issue, the value they attach to proposed safeguards as well as assessing their burden and unmet support needs.

Your opinion on this delicate issue is crucial. Resulting findings will help determine how society should respond to patients with dementia or to their families asking for assistance in dying.
